

Safety Rules for Swimming



- 1. Each child must have a signed permission form on file to participate in the swim program.
- 2. Each schoolage child will be required to pass a swim test with the lifeguards in order to go in water over their heads.
- 3. Each child must have his own swim suit and towel.
- 4. Children will be instructed to follow the listed safety rules:
 - Approach the pool area in an orderly manner
 - Always walk in the pool area; running is strictly forbidden.
 - Dive or jump in the water only after checking to see that no one is in the way.
 - Play safely in the water-climbing on other children, pushing, rough play is not acceptable.
 - Leave the pool promptly and orderly when the designated swim time is over.
- 5. Children will be escorted by a teacher when they leave the pool for any reason.
- 6. Teachers will station themselves around the pool so that they can clearly see all of the children.
- 7. Teachers will make every effort to encourage swimming skills and proper safety standards.
- 8. Teachers will have a list of the children attending any swimming session along with each child's swimming ability and record of whether they have taken/passed the swim test.
